

Tall Ted Road Safety Craft - assembly instructions

1. Cut all the pieces out using the dotted lines as a guide
2. Fold the pieces where you see a solid line and slot the base together
3. Place the small and large posts on the marked road squares (glue if desired)

Now you should have a craft that looks like the one pictured.



Instructions for crossing the road at a school crossing

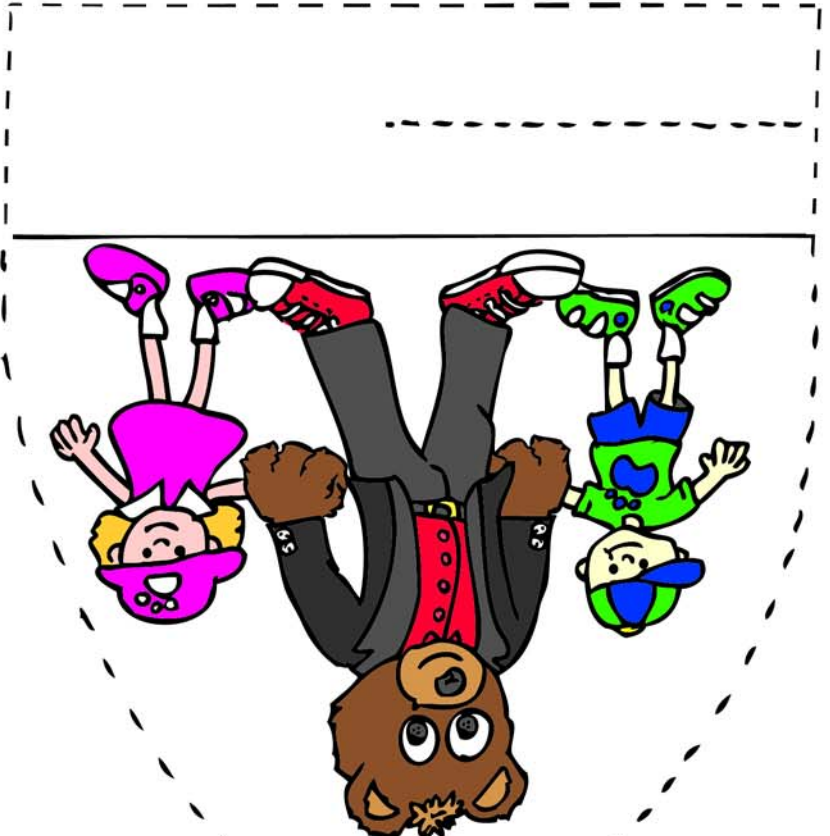
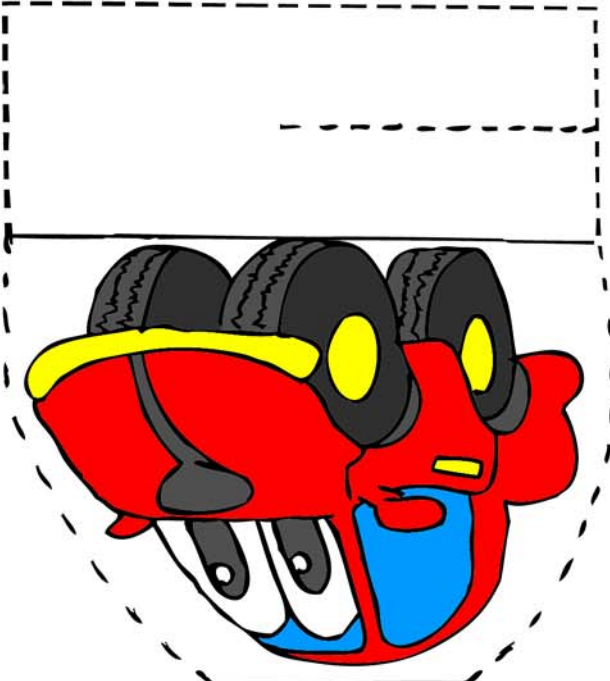
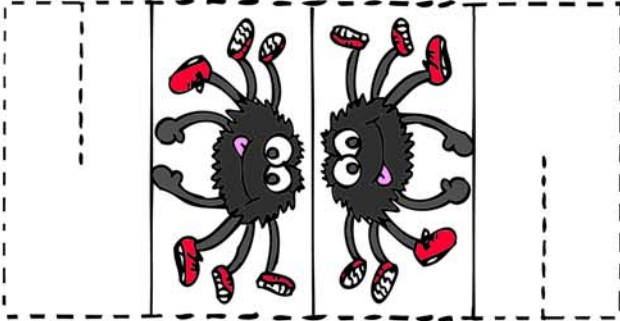
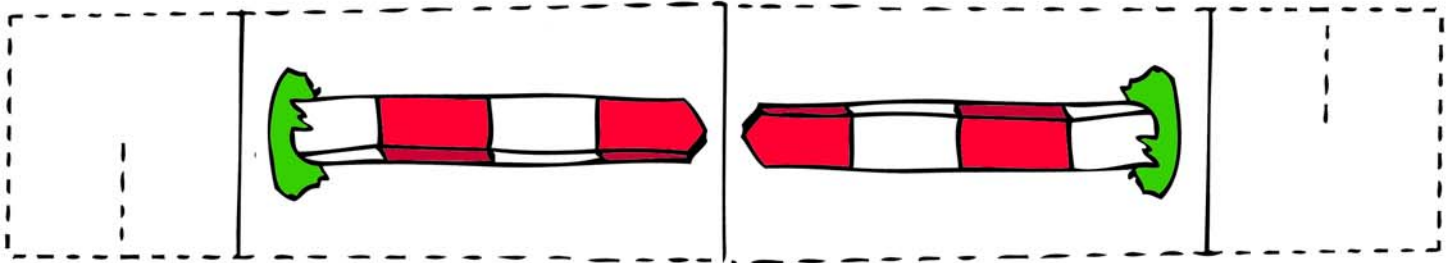
1. Stand back from the roadside while waiting to cross the road

3. Remember to look both ways before crossing and hold a grown ups hand
4. Walk across the road, staying in between the two white lines
5. Do not run, ride a bike or skateboard or bounce a ball when crossing the road

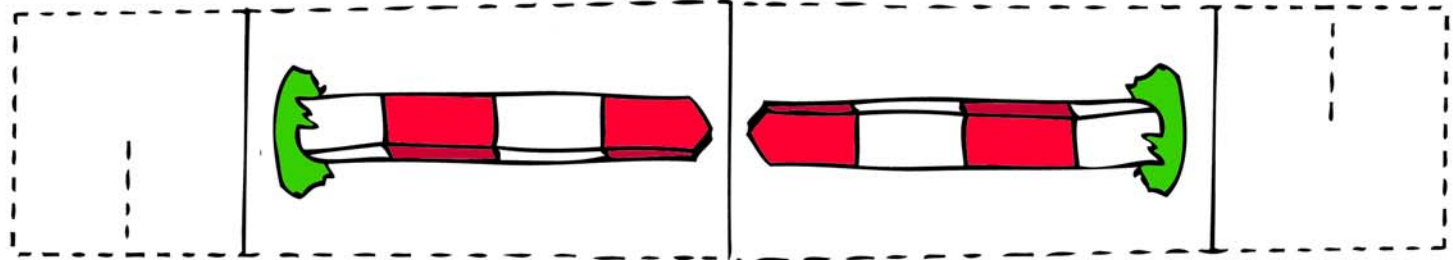
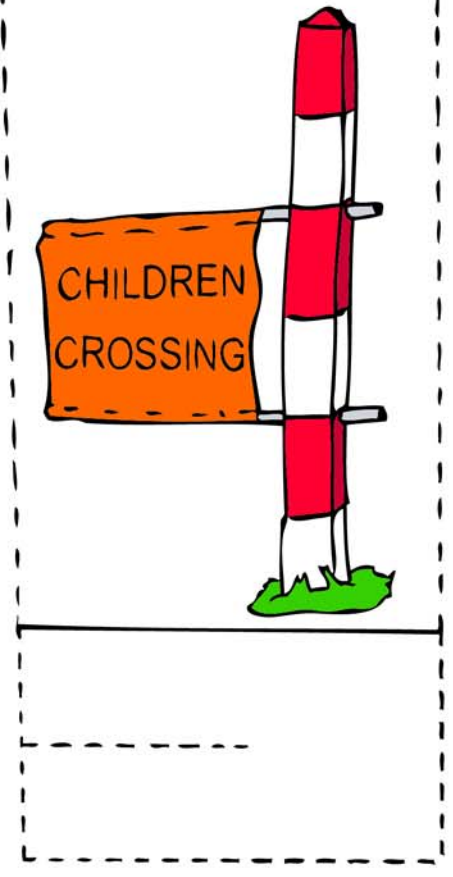
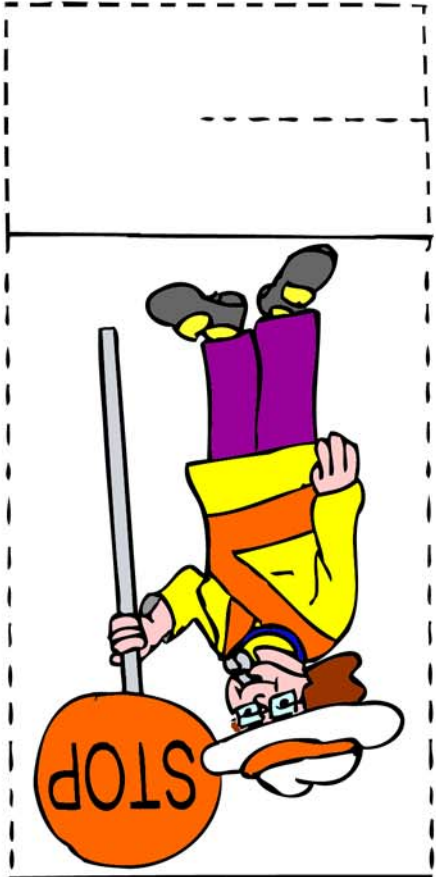
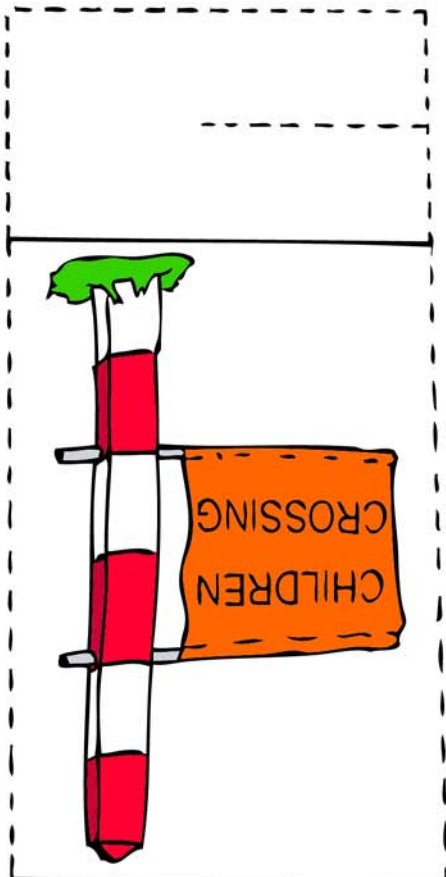

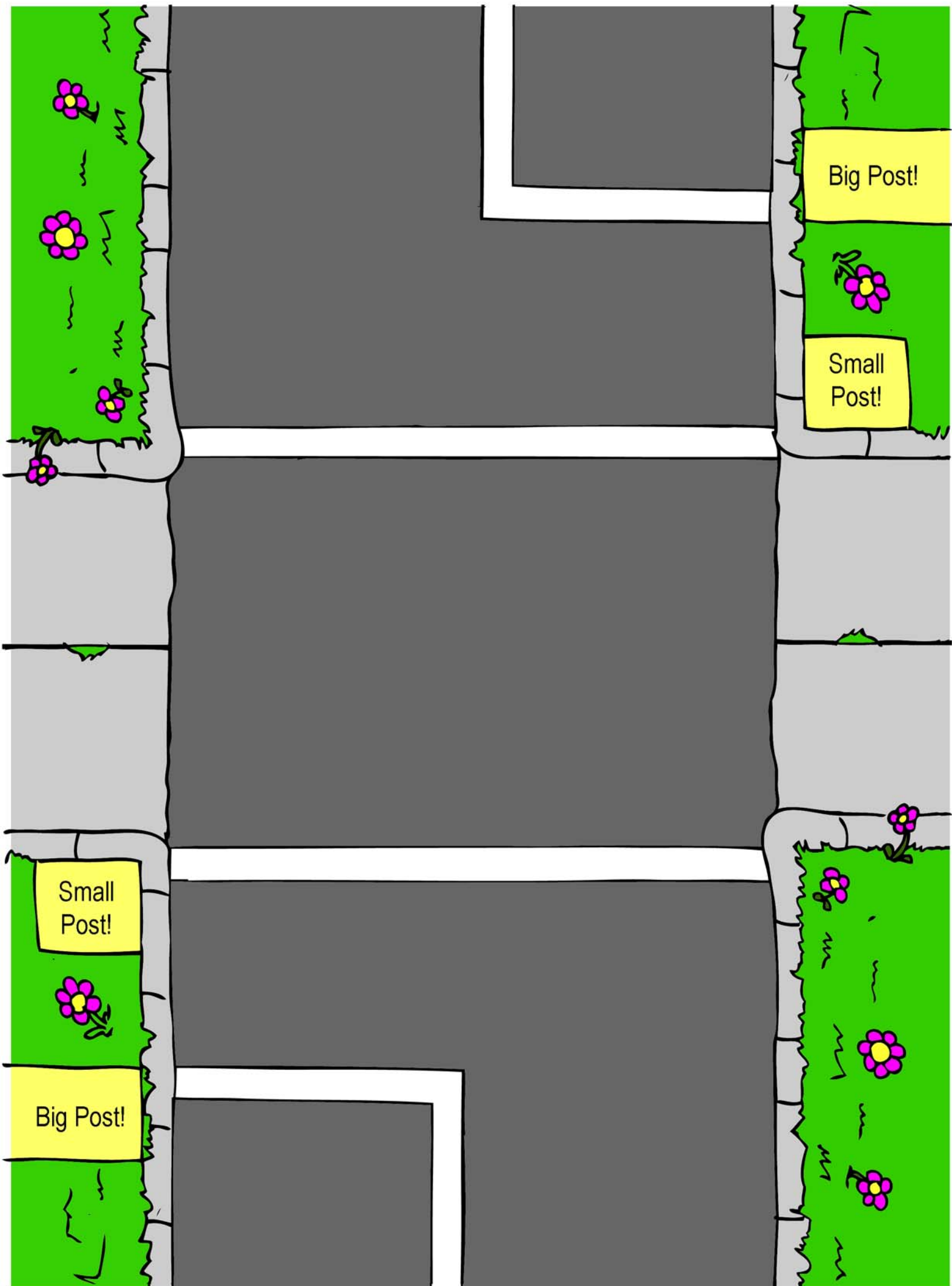
Ipsy Wipsy Spider Road Safety Nursery Rhyme
