- 1. Find a grownup to help you cut out the pieces, use the dotted lines as a guide
- 2. Fold all the pieces where you see a solid line and slot the base together
- 3. Place the small and large posts on the marked road squares (glue if desired)


Now you should have a craft that looks like the one pictured.



Instructions for crossing the road at a school crossing

- 1. Stand back from the roadside while waiting to cross the road
- 2. Wait for the Crossing Supervisor to blow the whistle twice
- 3. Remember to look both ways before crossing and hold a grown ups hand
- 4. Walk across the road, staying in between the two white lines
- 5. Do not run, ride a bike or skateboard or bounce a ball when crossing the road

Now there is just one more school crossing rule. If the Crossing Supervisor blows the whistle once in a long burst, you must **STOP IMMEDIATELY** as this means danger, look out!
